

You said: HOSE CLAMP 20 MM

A **20 mm hose clamp** is a versatile clamping fastener commonly used to create a leak-proof seal on flexible tubing, automotive lines, and household gas stoves with an **outside diameter (OD) around 20 mm (approx. 3/4 inch)**. [[1](#), [2](#), [3](#), [4](#), [5](#)]

Types of 20 mm Hose Clamps

- **Worm Drive Clamps:** These feature a slotted band and a screw mechanism. Standard sizes like **Size 00** or **Size 6** usually offer an adjustable range of **11 mm to 22 mm** or **13 mm to 20 mm**, making them perfect for standard 20 mm outer diameter hoses. - **Spring Band Clamps:** These offer constant tension. A **20 mm ID spring clamp** stays tight even during temperature fluctuations, commonly used in automotive cooling or fuel lines. [[1](#), [2](#), [3](#), [4](#)]
