



A welding electrode holder (often called a "stinger" or rod clamp) is a handheld tool used in stick (MMA) welding to securely grip the electrode. It conducts electrical current from the welding machine to the electrode, allowing a stable, continuous electric arc to form while protecting the welder from heat and electrical shocks.
